










Students are taught, learn, and work collaboratively to gain design experience in several interior environments in stimulating studio-based educational environments.

As a result, climate change and pollution are few among the countless hindrances that an architect must tackle today but given less to no concern in the past. Thus, it is time to start being cautious on resources used and following sustainable techniques that do not compromise on future The energy efficiency of a building involves considering the energy used by the building before, during, and after construction, which includes building services such as air conditioning, lighting, etc. Net-zero energy refers to the annual amount of energy created on-site equal to the total energy consumed by the building. Designing a building based on the native construction systems is beneficial beyond the preservation of the cultural aspect of the place. Vernacular architecture stresses utilizing materials within reach of the site, which in turn cuts down on transportation costs and reduces the chance of shortage of materials.
