#### 1. General Information

Ahlia University campus see hundreds of people every day. From instructors and students to visitors and guest speakers, our institution sees many new and similar faces.

A regular campus cleaning schedule is imperative for creating a welcoming and safe environment for everyone visiting our campus. The state of our institution reflects the care we give our space and resources, and a clean campus shows that we care about student success, staff productivity and general safety.

The benefits of campus cleaning include keeping our university members safe, productive, and proud to be a part of our community. Many potential students and other guests also evaluate the cleanliness of an institution before enrolling or visiting. Keeping our college campus clean has the following advantages:

- Boosting Productivity
- Promoting Safety
- · Nurturing Health
- Encouraging Enrollment

## 2. Definitions

#### Cleaning definitions in accordance with CDC guidelines :

- Disinfection (or Deep Cleaning) a process that eliminates pathogenic microorganisms, except bacterial spores, on inanimate objects. Objects are usually disinfected by liquid chemicals or wet pasteurization. Custodial staff use an EPA-approved disinfectant to coat and wipe down all accessible/visible surfaces.
- Regular cleaning the removal of visible soil (e.g., organic, and inorganic
  material) from objects and surfaces and normally is accomplished manually or
  mechanically using water with detergents or enzymatic products.
- Sterilization describes a process that destroys or eliminates all forms of
  microbial life and is carried out in health-care facilities by physical or chemical
  methods. Steam under pressure, dry heat, EtO gas, hydrogen peroxide gas
  plasma, UV lighting exposure and liquid chemicals are the principal sterilizing
  agents used in health-care facilities.

## 3. Cleaning procedures in the Ahlia University

#### General steps of cleaning in AU campus

- Remove general waste.
- High dust.
- · Clean & disinfect all flat surfaces.
- Clean & Disinfect restroom.
- Mop floor.
- Stock supplies and perform final inspection.
- Wet Mop floor.

#### **Regular cleaning protocol**

Priorities have been adjusted to provide for increased cleaning and disinfecting of high-traffic, high-touch surfaces.

# Examples of high-touch surfaces include

- Stair railings
- Exterior and interior door hardware and surfaces.
- Light switches.
- Restroom fixtures, partitions, faucets, toilet paper/paper towel dispensers.
- Elevator control panels and call buttons.
- Common area kitchen countertops and appliances

# Examples of high-traffic areas include

- Building entrances
- Restrooms
- Classrooms, lounges, and meeting spaces
- Hallways

- Every morning before class hours all the classrooms, labs, studios, offices. corridors, kitchens are cleaned well by dusting, brushing, moping etc.
- Carpets are cleaned routinely with vacuum cleaner.
- Medical or chemical spillages are cleaned accordingly as per the CDC and NHRA guidelines.
- Allocated a janitor for each toilet and regularly clean the toilets with disinfectant solutions.
- Routinely change the cleaning materials such as mop, brush etc.
- Adequately provided cleaning materials.
- Sufficient employees to clean and make the University neat and clean.
- Cleaning procedures are supervised by authorized person.
- The Campus Community is encouraged to practice preventative cleaning in their personal offices.
- Disinfecting high-touch surfaces in high-traffic areas is performed daily (and more frequently as schedules allow).
- Cleaning check list and toilet cleaning check list are properly followed.
- In case of any positive cases of communicable diseases, we follow MOH guidelines and thorough disinfection to be done by sanitization machine.
- We follow the safety rules in cleaning such as;
  - Keep Cleaning Safety a Top Priority
  - Reduce slips and falls by placing anti-slip strips on rugs.
  - Wear rubber gloves to avoid contact with chemicals.
  - Do not mix chemicals for any reason.
  - Secure cleaning products
  - Always dilute concentrated cleaning products before use.

## 4. Hygiene and Sanitization

- Provided sanitization materials and tools in all classes, labs, corridors, bathrooms, and all other facilities.
- Monitoring the compliance of cleaning companies with procedures, including the provision of sufficient numbers of workers to clean and disinfect toilets regularly after each use and sterilize classrooms and facilities daily, once everyone has left.
- Provided foot-operated lid-fitted waste bins throughout facility.
- Encourage strict hand washing routines and allow students adequate breaks to do that.
- Conduct a complete disinfection of all areas and surfaces, especially those frequently used, such as door handles, elevator buttons and appliances. Complete disinfection should also be carried out at the end of each day.

## 5. Disinfection of premises

- All classrooms, offices, corridors, water circulations and halls will be disinfected before class hours.
- Door handles and regularly used countertops will be cleaned regularly during the day.
- Each classroom /lab will be equipped with a bottle of hand sanitizer.
- Use the trash basket outside the classrooms/labs.
- Food and beverage not allowed in teaching and learning amenities.

#### **Toilets**

- Toilets must be regularly clean and disinfected.
- Allocated a janitor for each toilet.
- Provision of sufficient cleaning materials such as Harpic, Dettol, Clorox, Hand soap, tissues etc.

# **6. Typical AU Custodial Cleaning Tasks and Frequencies**

No	Location Type	Cleaning Provided	Frequency
1	All Buildings	Start day by removing any possible contaminated refuse and recyclables from buildings. Apply EPA-approved disinfectant to all required area.	Daily
2	Restrooms	Disinfect all toilets, sinks, urinals, and mirrors. Remove trash, sweep, and mop floors, replace paper products and hand soap.	Daily and as needed
3	Entrances, Lobbies, Hallways and Restrooms	Disinfect all high-touch areas	Daily
4	Lobbies	Sweep, mop and/or auto scrub floors, vacuum carpets and remove trash, wipe furniture, clean glass doors.	Daily
5	Classrooms	Remove trash, sweep, spot mop floors. Disinfect surfaces daily.	Daily and as needed
6	Lecture Halls	Remove trash, sweep, spot mop floors. Disinfect surfaces daily.	Daily and As needed
7	Offices / Cubicles	Remove trash, Spot clean, hi-dust, dust, spot mop hard floors	Daily and as needed
8	Stairwells	Disinfect handrails and doorknobs	Daily
9	Carpeted Floors	Vacuum private offices, office suites, Vacuum public spaces, hallways, carpeted classrooms, conference rooms.	Weekly and as needed
10	Tile Floors	Dust mop, damp mop, spot mop	Daily
11	Light Fixtures	Relamp (below 10 feet)	As needed


#### 1. TOILET BOWL

- D. Dry Surface as required




#### 2. CLEAN WASH BASEN
