Using QR codes library users can download reading lists or search results directly to their phone.

1. Access Liberty OPAC: Visit our library's website and click on the "Liberty OPAC" link (<u>https://ahlia.libertyasp.co.uk/library/libraryHome.do</u>).



Anyone who can access the library's home screen can search the library's catalogue without having to log in, however options



such as saving searches, placing reservations, or renewing on-loan items are not available until borrowers have logged in.



A login link is situated in the top right corner of the screen.

#### 2. Search for Resources

• Advanced Search: For more precise results, use the advanced search options to filter by author, title, subject, or publication year.
